The petitioner seeks protection of life and liberty of her son Deepak Kumar alias Binni, aged about 23 years, who is confined in Central Jail, Amritsar, in case pertaining to FIR No. 34, dated 6.3.2014, registered under Sections 302, 382 IPC at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur. The petitioner further seeks investigation in two FIRs, registered against her son during the confinement in jail. FIR No. 64, dated 22.5.2016, was registered under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur and FIR No. 81, dated 29.6.2016, was registered under Section 307 IPC, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Garhshanker, District Hoshiarpur.

The State has already filed the reply. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, states that in both the

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said FIRs (Annexure-P-1 and Annexure-P-2), challans have been presented and cases are at different stage. Therefore, the son of petitioner has to take appropriate defence plea during those trials.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that the petitioner apprehends danger to the life of her son and prays that he should be duly protected when produced before different courts as the son of petitioner is facing different cases.

The State is ready to take care of the life and liberty of son of the petitioner.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the State that whenever Deepak Kumar alias Binni, son of the petitioner, is to be produced before any Court, the police shall take necessary care to see that the son of the petitioner is not harmed.
