Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.50 dated 28.05.2017 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated July 31, 2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurvinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.07.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
