In FIR No.70 dated 14.07.2016, under Sections 420, 406, 494, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur, Punjab, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 17.08.2016 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to make statement regarding compliance of the order dated 17.08.2016, whereby instructions were to be taken for return of money. In that view of the matter, the petitioner does not have intention to return money. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused has been granted bail. The same is irrelevant.

Hence, this petition is dismissed. Interim order dated

17.08.2016 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner stands vacated.
