The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 06 dated 08.01.2017 under Sections 307, 323, 34 IPC and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Kot-Kapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner had raised a *lalkara* while co-accused Gurjant Singh had fired a shot from his pistol which hit the right arm of the complainant. He further contends that vague allegations of beating the complainant when he was lying down are mentioned in the FIR. The petitioner is in custody for almost 06 months, ever since the day of his arrest on 25.02.2017.

Heard.

The petitioner is in custody for almost five and a half months, ever since his arrest on 25.02.2017. No specific injury has been

attributed to the petitioner and co-accused Gurjant Singh is stated to have fired a shot from his pistol which hit the right arm of the complainant. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time.

Consequently, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Raju Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
