Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in pursuance of the order dated 31.07.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner No.2-Gurpreet Singh has joined investigation and the recovery has been effected. It is further contended that his presence is not required for further custodial interrogation by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Baldev Singh, has not disputed the assertion of the learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the stand of both the parties, the interim anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner on 31.07.2017 is made absolute.
