The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 136 dated 22.06.2017 under Sections 379-B, 34 of IPC registered at Police Station, Division No.6 District Ludhiana.

Custody certificate filed in Court is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR which has been registered against the unknown persons who had snatched mobile phone and wallet of the complainant having Rs. 300/-. It was also stated that petitioner is only 18 years of age and no other case has ever been registered against him and he is in custody ever since the date of his arrest on 22.06.2017.

Heard.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR. He is only 18 years of age and is in custody ever since the date of his arrest on 22.06.2017. I

deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Consequently, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Mukesh @ Rakesh Kumar @ Munna Thakur is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, he shall abide by the terms envisaged under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
