Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.5 to 14.

Pursuant to the notice issued by this Court vide order dated 27.01.2017, reply by way of affidavit of Gaurav Garg, IPS, SSP, Ferozepur has already been filed on behalf of respondents No.1, 2 and 4.

As per the said reply, respondent No.9 Neeraj daughter of Bhola Singh has moved an application before the SHO Police Station Zira against the petitioner. In the application, it has been alleged that the petitioner while making false promise of marriage has maintained physical relationship with

respondent No.9. On 11.10.2016 at about 2.30 AM, the petitioner had forcibly entered into the house of respondent No.9 and had given beating to her. He had snatched her mobile phone as well.

Therefore, on the basis of reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1,2 and 4, this Court finds that there is some dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.9. Along with the reply, a Panchayatnama (Annexure R-2/T) has also been filed, which is signed by father of respondent No.9 stating therein that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the marriage of respondent No.9 Neeraj has been solemnized with petitioner Nirvair Singh in Gurudwara Sabha Zira according to rites and rituals.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.4 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur that in case it is found that there is any merit in the prayer made by the petitioner, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.
