The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No.66 dated 29.06.2015, under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigation Officer, submits that though the petitioners have joined the investigation, still one LCD, one cooler, Rs.50,000/- cash given

for motorcycle and 03 gram gold are yet to be recovered from them.

In view of the facts that the petitioners have joined the investigation and mediation has failed in this case, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 19.08.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
