By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.109 dated 15.07.2016, registered under Sections 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station City Samana, Patiala.

It is contended that the compromise has been reached between the parties.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that in pursuance of order dated 17.08.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He further admits the factum of compromise.

The learned counsel for the complainant also admits the factum of compromise.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.08.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
