The petitioner is seeking direction to respondent No.1 to protect her life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4 and thereafter, arrest respondent No.4, who is extending threats to her and her family members.

Allegation against respondent No.4 is that he had committed rape upon the petitioner.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 has been filed, wherein it has been stated that on the basis of statement made by the petitioner, FIR No.74 dated 17.05.2016, under Sections 366, 376, 342 and 506 IPC was registered at Women Police Station, Faridabad. After registration of the FIR, petitioner was got medically examined and her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. was got recorded. During investigation, call details of mobile phone No.9971322777 were obtained, which was found to be of one Shyam Babu, but he was not traceable at the

given address. Copies of call details have been annexed as Annexure R-1. The petitioner did not join investigation. On 07.06.2016, one Ram Babu son of Umed Singh, resident of House No.925, Sector 15-A, Faridabad made an application to the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad regarding a gang of persons involved in extorting money from respectable persons by involving them in the cases of rape etc. He had specifically stated that one Ved Parkash, in connivance with Sanjay, Vinay Bhatia, Jaiveer, Seema Kaur (petitioner), Anita Jain along with some other persons were in the habits of getting cases registered against respectable persons. A case bearing FIR No.74 dated 17.05.2016 has been registered against Seema Kaur-petitioner. It was further stated that those persons were demanding Rs.25,00,000/- from them. After receipt of complaint, a raid was conducted and Rs.2,00,000/- were recovered from Ved Parkash, which he had taken as a token money from Ram Babu. Thereafter, FIR No.314 dated 07.06.2016, under Sections 384, 506, 34, 120-B IPC was registered at Police Station, Central, Faridabad against Ved Prakash, Seema Kaur-petitioner and their companions. Despite making efforts, petitioner has not joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that cancellation report has been prepared in case FIR No.74 dated 17.05.2016 (Annexure P-1).

In view of the reply filed, no directions are required to be issued in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
