Petitioner-Jaswant Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.114 dated 13.05.2016, registered at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC and Section 477 of IPC, added later on.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations against the present petitioner, he presented a forged cheque, amounting to more than ₹90 lakhs, before the bank, but the same was not encashed. Other

allegation against the present petitioner is that he withdrew ₹90,000/- illegally from the bank through ATM.

The petitioner has been in custody since 04.04.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
