Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.557 dated 5.7.2017, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal. Seen the impugned order and the reasons recorded therein by the trial court. Learned State Counsel submits that the accused persons allured the complainant to invest an amount of Rs.20 lacs in the business with the promise that he will be getting the benefits out of the business. However, the complainant has not been given any benefits and that is why the FIR has been lodged. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and anticipatory bail is granted to the satisfaction of the Investing Officer. He shall, however, join the investigation and fully cooperate with Investigating Officer and shall also comply with the conditions laid down under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
