Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58 dated 25.08.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 326 and 307 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, Distirct Batala (Gurdaspur).

Learend counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 02.06.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time. The matter has been compromised between the parties. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contended that there is a cross version of this occurrence and the present petitioner is injured in the said case and now the compromise has been effected between the parties in both the cases.

Learend counsel for the complainant as well as learned State counsel affirmed the fact regarding entering into the compromise.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 02.06.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Gurdaspur.

The petition stands allowed.
