Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought his regular bail in case F.I.R. No.59 dated 22.04.2017 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the Act') registered at Police Station City South, District Moga.

According to the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended with 43200 tablets containing ALPRAZOLAM DIZIFRESH 0.5 salt which comes under the definition of “narcotic substance” under the Act.

In view of the admission made by learned counsel for the State that the State that the petitioner was having a valid licence to keep the aforesaid tablets, the possession of the petitioner over 43200 tablets having ALPRAZOLAM DIZIFRESH 0.5 salt cannot be said to be illegal.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is granted regular bail pending trial, subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Judge, Special Court, Moga.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
