This is a petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner in case FIR No. 83 dated 18.6.2017 registered under Sections 307/392/34, IPC at Police Station Mataur, District SAS, Nagar.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner was not named in the FIR and has been arrested on the disclosure statement made by the co-accused Ajay Thakur. He further submitted that the petitioner is 19 years of age, who is a student and his career will be affected in case he is not granted the concession of bail. He has further submitted that his co-accused Ajay Thakur has already been granted the concession of bail vide order dated 29.7.2017 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 4.8.2017 in Court today. The same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI, Avtar Singh has submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case and has already undergone 1 month 4 days of actual custody.

Keeping in view the above fact, the present petition is allowed.
Petitioner is released on bail on furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of
CJM/Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali,

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for
cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other
subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
