Earlier CRM-M No.16324 of 2017 was filed by the
petitioner.

On 10.05.2017, notice of motion was issued on the
statement of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner
was ready to settle the issue with the complainant. The case
was adjourned for 26.05.2017 and the arrest of the petitioner
was stayed till then. On 26.05.2017, the petition was disposed
of on the statement of the petitioner that he would deposit an
amount of Rs.5 lac by way of bank draft in favour of the
complainant within two weeks. The petition was disposed of
accordingly.

Thereafter, CRM Nos.22647-48 of 2017 were filed in the aforesaid petition for extension of time in depositing the amount. CRM No.22648 of 2017 was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 27.07.2017.

Petitioner has filed this second petition for grant of anticipatory bail. Once the indulgence was not granted to the petitioner for depositing the amount by way of extending the time, then in my considered opinion, no indulgence can be granted to the petitioner in the manner as suggested by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
