Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to investigate the application dated 03.06.2016 moved by the petitioner to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-2) through some independent agency. Prayer has also been made to issue a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to arrest the respondents No.4 to 8 and to take appropriate action against them. Prayer for a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents has also been made in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has made a complaint to the police on 03.06.2016 mentioning therein that the petitioner and his family members are living under fear because of threat

perceptions received at the hands of accused.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the fact that the representation (Annexure P-2) was made on 03.06.2016 and thereafter, there is no such representation to the police or any other authority, is sufficient to infer that there is no continuous threat to the petitioner, as being alleged in the present petition.

Thus, there is no merit in the instant petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
