The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.94 dated 11.10.2016 registered under Sections 302, 323, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner, who is a woman, was arrested on 11.10.2016 and is in jail since then. The evidence of the material witnesses has been recorded. I perused the statement of PW-1-Gamdoor Singh the star witness of the prosecution. Perusal of which shows, prima facie, that except for the attribution of brick bats to the Harpal Kaur, nothing has been attributed to her.

In that view of the matter, the detention of the petitioner, who is a woman, is no more necessary as under trial and therefore, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-27816 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
