Petitioner-Virender alias Satpal has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.215 dated 27.06.2013, registered at Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani, under Sections 307 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

It has been brought into notice of this Court by learned State counsel that trial is already complete and case is fixed for arguments.

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On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner argued that in the connected case, which is fixed for January, 2018, proceedings before the trial Court have been stayed.

The petitioner has been in custody since 21.07.2013 i.e. more than four years. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The conclusion of trial will take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
