INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Lovepreet Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.202 dated 17.06.2017, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala, under Sections 364-A, 394, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, Vishal son of complainant-Chandan Singh, was got kidnapped for the purpose of ransom and ₹2 crores were demanded.

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As per learned State counsel, even a gold chain has been recovered from the present petitioner. In the present case, no witness has been examined so far.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that no witness has been examined so far and that if the petitioner is released on bail, there is every chance of tampering with the evidence by him, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
