Petitioners have filed these petitions under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.266 dated 27.12.2016, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 148, 149, 186, 307, 332, 353, 379, 427, 506 of Indian Penal Code (Section 325 of Indian Penal Code added later on).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State and contested both these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as

learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present case, no injury has been declared as dangerous to life and the injuries are only under Section 325 IPC.

The petitioners are in custody since 31.12.2016. They are not required for any custodial interrogation or investigation purposes as they are in judicial custody. Nothing is to be recovered from them. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal/surety bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
