ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.98 dated 08.03.2017, under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner could not appear in the Court in the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act as he was posted at another place. She further states that the complainant has now withdrawn the complaint as reflected in the order of the trial Court dated 22.11.2016 (Annexure P-4).

This Court, by the order dated 21.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting

Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lal Chand, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 21.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
