The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 118, dated 26.05.2017, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR, which has been registered by Darshan Lal, are that he had asked the complainant, who is running his sweet shop, to pay a sum of ₹15,000/- to Kapil Bhardwaj, who was impersonating as a Health official. Although the incident took place on 07/08.12.2016 but the FIR was registered after elapse of over 05 months.

This Court, vide order dated 02.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of

Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 02.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
