2. On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior Deputy
Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

3. In this petition, the petitioner seeks a blanket anticipatory bail
as he apprehends being falsely implicated in some criminal case which
might be registered in Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur
out of political vendetta and bias imputed to respondent No.2, who happens
to be the Station House Officer of the said Police Station. It is seen that a
similar prayer of the petitioner was rejected by the Ld. Court of Sessions on

the ground that no anticipatory bail could be granted in the absence of any

actual pending case. This Court is in full agreement with the aforesaid observation of the Ld. Court below.

4. In the circumstances, the matter is disposed off with a direction upon the respondent to inform the petitioner in writing about the lodging of an FIR, if any, against him in future, and to give him a reasonable time (upto 7 days) to avail of appropriate remedies.
