Petitioner-Ram Parsad Yadav @ Ram Parsad has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.81 dated 16.02.2017, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari, under Sections 181, 200 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that allegation against the present petitioner is that he got double allotment of plot in HUDA by misrepresentation etc.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 02.08.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. The case is based on documentary evidence. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 02.08.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
