This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of orders dated 16.01.2017, 25.01.2017 and 27.02.2017, Annexures P-4 to P-6 respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has never avoided appearance before the police or in the Court. She was wrongly declared a proclaimed person, she came to know about it when it was intimated by the Investigating Officer during the pendency of the application for grant of pre-arrest bail so filed by her, where she had even joined the investigation.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to

surrender in the trial Court within seven days from today and to move an application for regular bail which be decided within ten days.

The petitioner shall not be arrested till the decision of the regular bail.
