Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.1 has gone abroad, therefore, qua her the present petition is no more survives and be dismissed as such

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Since the petitioners have approached this Court under Section

482 Cr.P.C. for seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for their protection on the ground of matrimony, but in the absence of petitioner No.1, this Court does not find any ground to grant protection to the petitioner No.2, more particularly when the petitioners have made a joint representation (Annexure P-5).

However, in case petitioner No.2 still apprehend threat to his life and liberty, he may approach the SHO/ Police Authority concerned for such relief.

Dismissed.
