Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.195 dated 21.10.2015 registered under Sections 279,
337 and 338 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Phase 1, SAS
Nagar, District SAS Nagar, the petitioner is being prosecuted.

The parties to the dispute have now arrived at compromise.
This Court had made an order dated October 06, 2016 directed the trial
Court/Illaqa Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of the
compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Now, there is a report received from Chief Judicial Magistrate,
SAS Nagar Mohali, showing that indeed there is a compromise arrived at
between the parties and statements in view of compromise have been
recorded and compromise that is arrived at between the parties with the
intervention of the respectable persons is genuine and without any pressure,

coercion or undue influence.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.195 dated 21.10.2015 registered under Sections 279, 337 and 338 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Phase 1, SAS Nagar, District SAS Nagar, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
