The petitioners are seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend threat from respondents No.4 to 7.

Petitioner No.1 and Petitioner No.2 is stated to be born in the year 1997 and 1996 respectively and copies of their Aadhar cards in support thereof, are annexed as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to have solemnized their marriage on 30.07.2017. The marriage certificate and photographs in this regard are annexed as Annexure P-3 and Annexure P-4, respectively. It is further stated in the petition that the petitioners had also made a representation dated 30.07.2017 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur but no action has so far been taken thereon.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Seena Mand, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and keeping in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P and another, JT 2006 (6) SC 173**, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.
