ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.81 dated 20.12.2016 under Sections 307/452/427/323/324/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is outcome of road rage and the co-accused had also received injuries in the said incident, as a result of which, they have also lodged cross DDR. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over three months ever since his arrest on 28.04.2017 and the matter has also been compromised between the parties. They have also preferred petitions bearing CRM-M-21892-2017 and CRM-M-21896-2017 for quashing the aforementioned FIR and DDR on the basis of compromise, which are listed on 05.09.2017. A similarly situated co-accused namely Sukhpreet Singh @ Sukha has also been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 13.07.2017 passed in CRM-M-23386 of 2017.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The incident is stated to have taken place due to sudden quarrel between the parties, who have now compromised the matter. The petitioner is in custody for a period of over 3 months. The aforementioned co-accused has been granted regular bail.

In view of the aforementioned facts and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Mangi Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
