Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing Complaint No.65 dated 04.08.2009, under Sections 420/465/467/468/171/120-B IPC (Annexure P-1) and setting aside judgment dated 13.06.2014 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot (Annexure P-2), on the basis of compromise (Annexure-P3)

Pursuant to the order dated 03.08.2017 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 01.09.2017 to get their statements recorded. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot has also sent his report bearing No. 739 dated 01.09.2017 duly forwarded by District and Sessions Judge, Faridkot vide letter bearing No.2736/E.B. Dated 01.09.2017.

According to the report, the Chief Judicial Magistrate is satisfied that the parties have made an amicable settlement without any pressure or coercion or under influence.

Considering the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot dated 01.09.2017 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, Complaint No. 65 dated 04.08.2009 under Sections 420/465/467/468/171/120-B IPC (Annexure P-1) and judgment dated 13.06.2014 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot (Annexure P-2) are set aside, on the basis of compromise (Annexure-P3).

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
