The petitioner is seeking regular bail in complaint case bearing SC No. 45, dated 29.07.2005, registered under Sections 148, 325, 324, 323 read with Section 149 IPC recorded as cross version in FIR No. 93, dated 21.06.2003, under Sections 307, 325, 323 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the complaint is outcome of a dispute between family members, which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables. He further states that the petitioner has been in custody for over 03 months ever since the date of his arrest on 29.04.2017.

Mr. Rajan Bansal, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2/complainant and states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

Heard.

The complaint is an offshoot of a dispute between family members, which has now been resolved. The petitioner has been in custody for over 03 months. I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Balwinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
