The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 58, dated 08.04.2017, under Section 306, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR, which has been registered by the brother of the deceased, are that the petitioner, who was father-in-law of the deceased, along with other relatives used to beat and harass his sister. He further contends that no suicide note has been recovered and the incident has occurred after 13 years of marriage. Learned counsel further states that the sister of the deceased is also married to other son of the petitioner and they are residing happily and there is no allegation of harassment or interference in their marital life. He also states that the petitioner is over 70 years of age and has been in custody for about 04 months ever since the date of his arrest on 10.04.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the

petitioner, especially, when the petitioner is 70 years old and is in custody for about 04 months, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Banwari Lal is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
