Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.179 dated 09.06.2017 under Section 323/328/34/506 IPC registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 01.08.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 is taken on record.

This Court vide order dated 03.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned

Magistrate has submitted report dated 31.08.2017 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

A joint statement has been made by the complainant and his brother Sushil Kumar that they have compromised the matter without any pressure voluntarily. They have no differences any more and the compromise is accepted.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and F.I.R. No.179 dated 09.06.2017 under Section 323/328/34/506 IPC registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise dated 01.08.2017 (Annexure P-1).
