In these circumstances, without issuing notice to respondents, present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, to look into the complaint of the petitioner dated 27.7.2017 (Annexure-P-1) and take necessary corrective measures.
