Counsel, at the very outset, prays for withdrawal of the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.23 dated 25.4.2016 under sections 15, 25, 29 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Mehal Kalan, District Barnala, with liberty to approach the court below by filing an application under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.

It is, however, made clear that the liberty that has been granted to the petitioner would not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case even as regards the prayer for default bail is concerned.
