On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.J. Jauhar, Senior D.A.G.,
Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The petitioner, who is the complainant in F.I.R. No. 43, dated 29.03.2017, registered under Sections 325/323/427/148/149 I.P.C., at Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, has prayed for a direction upon the respondents/Police authorities to act on his representation (Annexures P-3) and to conduct the investigation in an impartial manner against the private respondents No. 4 to 17.

The petitioner's case is that he had given a supplementary statement before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, on account of which certain offences ought to have been included in the Final

Report to be submitted by the Police. But the authorities are allegedly not taking the action as required.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's allegations, the instant petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No. 2 to pass a speaking order on the petitioner's representation (Annexure P-3), a fresh copy of which may be supplied to the said respondent.

Such speaking order shall be passed within a period of one month of supplying of the fresh copy of the representation.
