The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 93 dated 23.6.2015 for offence punishable under Section 302 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (in short "IPC") (Section 306/34 IPC added later) registered at police station, Satnali, District, Mohindergarh.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 3.7.2015 and conclusion of trial is likely to take its own time.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Virender Singh, assisted by counsel for the complainant would submit that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the case is fixed for recording statement of the accused under Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
