The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the complaint dated 08.07.2017 to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent No.4, despite the complaint dated 08.07.2017 (Annexure P-1). Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the complaint should be decided expeditiously.
