The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.150 dated 28th March, 2017, registered under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

It is submitted *inter alia* that petitioner-Balwan Singh has remained in detention for over six months even though no Chemical Analysis Report pertaining to the recovery made from him has been forthcoming.

It is also submitted that there is no record of the petitioner being ever involved or apprehended in any other such case and that the co-accused, namely Sunil Kumar in the present case is already on bail.

In the circumstances, the present petitioner, namely Balwan Singh is also ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.

Disposed off accordingly.
