Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.12 dated 25.06.2016 registered under Sections 380, 406 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station NRI, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 11.07.2016 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide orders dated 22.08.2016 and 17.11.2016 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, police Station NRI, District Ludhiana within 15 days, for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the Magistrate to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Chief

Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana on 28.11.2016 and got recorded their

statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter No.1965 dated 29.11.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide letter No.1001/EC dated 03.12.2016.

According to the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana, the compromise arrived at between the parties is complete and acceptable.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.12 is quashed qua the petitioners, subject to depositing costs of ₹10,000/- by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
