Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.97 dated 21.5.2016, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 109, 120-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Nakodar, during the pendency of the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 25.5.2017 and the other co-accused namely Sukhjit Singh @ Sucha and Rahul have already been admitted on bail by this Court. He has referred to CRM-M-24010 of 2016 titled 'Sukhjit Singh @ Sucha vs. State of Punjab', whereby vide order dated 1.8.2016 co-accused Sukhjit Singh @ Sucha was admitted on bail by this Court. He further states that as per the

CT-Scan report, the injury on the person of complainant is small extradural hematoma parietal region.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that other co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Sukhjit Singh @ Sucha and Rahul have already been granted bail. However, it is the petitioner, who has caused injury to the complainant, which was grievous in nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Sukhjit Singh @ Sucha and Rahul have already been granted regular bail by this Court and trial of the case will take sufficient long time, the petition is **accepted**. The petitioner is admitted on regular bail on furnishing of his bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner has put undue pressure on the complainant/injured, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.
