INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Jaswinder Singh, has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.28 dated 14.02.2017, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that allegation of fraud of ₹10 lakhs on the pretext of sending the complainant's son abroad is against main accused-Mohd. Saleem, who is absconding.

All the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The petitioner has been in custody since 03.04.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
