Petitioners-Manjit Kaur and Ajay have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 6, who are parents and brother of petitioner No.1. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are extending threats to them. Affidavit of petitioner No.1 (Annexure P-1), copy of *aadhar* card (Annexure P-2) of petitioner No.2 and photographs of marriage (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners have been placed on record.

Vide order dated 03.08.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner No.1 was directed to produce her matriculation certificate showing her date of birth, but she has not produced it.

Heard.

Respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to look into the representation dated 02.08.2017 (Annexure P-4), given by petitioner No.1-Manjit Kaur. Respondent No.2 will assess the threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if he/she satisfies that there is a serious threat to their lives and liberty, he/she will take necessary steps immediately for the protection of their lives and liberty.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
