Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.87 dated 26.03.2017, under Sections 341/379-B/506 of IPC Act, registered at Police Station City Chandhut, District Palwal (Haryana).

Learned counsel for the State fairly submits on instructions from the officer, who is present in Court to assist him that there is no other case against the petitioner. He further submits that out of 11 prosecution witnesses 3 have been examined.

In this view of the matter, since there is no other case to his credit, pending or otherwise, a chance for reformation should be given to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate / Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall attend the police station concerned where he resides on every Monday,

Wednesday and Sunday between 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM every week. Petitioner shall file an undertaking before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
