Petitioners-Gurmeet Singh and Gurpreet Singh @ Tinku have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') seeking blanket anticipatory bail and for issuance of necessary directions to I.O/S.H.O, P.S.City Jalalabad, not to arrest them and in the event of their arrest, they may be granted blanket anticipatory bail in case FIR Dated Nil, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka and they also prayed that prior notice of 10 days before the registration of FIR be issued to them.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel, I find that copy of complaint/application, which was given to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jalalabad, has been placed on record as Annexure P-2. I have perused the said application/complaint given to the police, in which the present petitioners apprehend their arrest. Perusal of the complaint shows that dispute is regarding non-payment of the goods purchased by the present petitioners.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find that there is merit in the present petition. It is ordered that if the petitioners are to be arrested on the basis of allegations as mentioned in application/complaint (Annexure P-2), then a written prior notice of 07 days of their arrest be given to them.
