This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.14 dated 9.1.2017 under sections 420 I.P.C and Section 66 of I.T Act, registered at Police Station, Sector 55, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR has been registered at the instance of Mr. Pankaj Suri, who controls an organization M/s Accord Automation Pvt. Ltd., Faridabad. Allegations against the present petitioner are that he has stolen certain vital information of the complainant company while serving as an employee and has shared it with co-accused Suresh Muthreja, who was also in the same business and thereby causing loss to M/s Accord Automation Pvt. Ltd.

Petitioner was arrested on 10.1.2017.

Even though, the matter is still stated to be under investigation, co-accused Suresh Muthreja has been granted ad interim protection as regards arrest by this Court in the light of order dated 27.1.2017 passed in CRM No. M-2720 of 2017.

It is not the case made out on behalf of the State that the petitioner, if, granted benefit of bail would be in a position to hamper the course of a free and fair investigation.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.

Petition disposed of.
