ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 13.07.2017 under Sections 307/323/34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he had grappled with Angrej singh-father of the complainant and beaten him up. He further contends that Angrej Singh has not suffered any injury. Two gun shot wounds which have been found on the person of Gurpreet Singh in the MLR, are specifically attributed to Tajwinder Singh.

This Court, by the order dated 04.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 04.08.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 04.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
