ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.105 dated 22.04.2017 under Sections 306/201/120-B registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are vague and do not, *prima facie*, constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC. He also contends that the petitioner is 76 years old.

This Court by the order dated 04.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 04.08.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 04.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
