The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 348 dated 27.09.2016 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Butana, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had taken money from the complainant to permanently settle his nephew in New Zealand. He further states that petitioner is willing to compromise the matter.

This Court vide order dated 08.08.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of

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Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ram Niwas states that in pursuance to the order dated 08.08.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 08.08.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
